HAVE ENOUGH TO EAT!



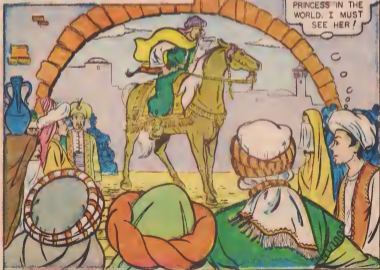
BY SELLING THE GOLD AND SILVER THE

NOT TRY TO BECOME WEALTHY.



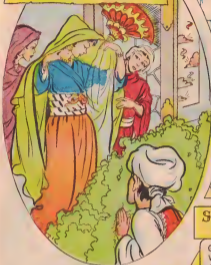
THE YEARS PASSED ONE DAY.

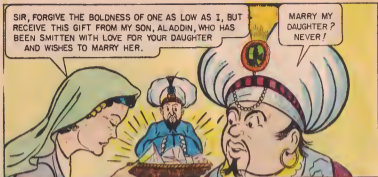
SO ALADDIN'S MOTHER WENT TO SEE THE SULTAN.

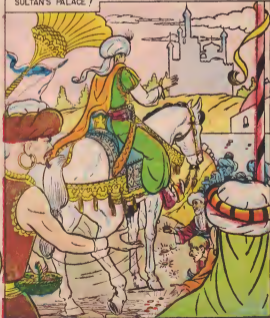

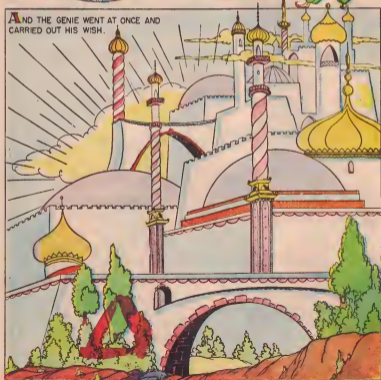

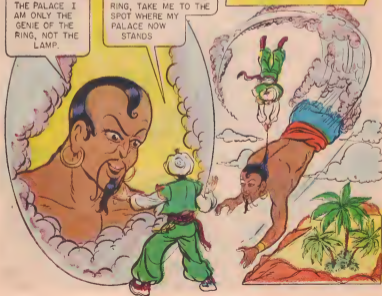
MY PALACE! DO YOU KNOW WHERE MY PALACE IS? CAN YOU BRING IT BACK TO ME?

THE PRINCESS AND ALADDIN HELD THEIR BREATH AS THE CUP WAS DRAINED

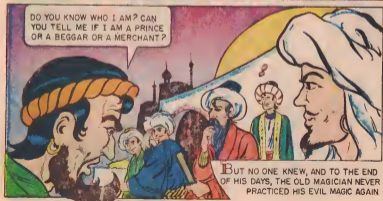
AT ONCE, THE MAGICIAN FELL BACK, ASLEEP.

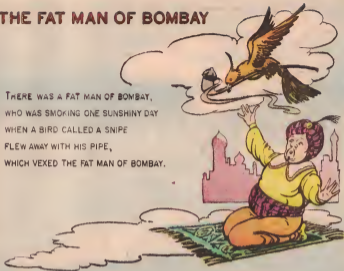

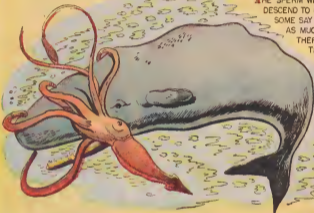

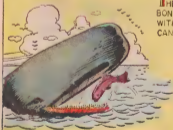
