OH, IT IS QUITE SAFE. I WON'T GO FAR, I PROMISE.

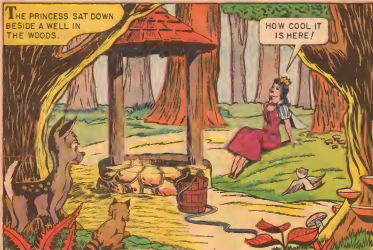


AND OFF SHE RAN...

THE FROG LOOKED SO FUNNY WITH HER JEWELS ON THAT EVEN THE PRINCESS HAD TO LAUGH.

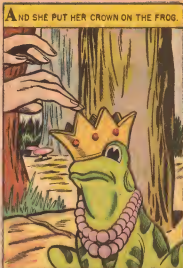


NO, DEAR PRINCESS. YOUR JEWELS ARE NOT FOR ME

WHY, HOME WITH YOU, OF COURSE! HAVE YOU FORGOTTEN YOUR PROMISE?



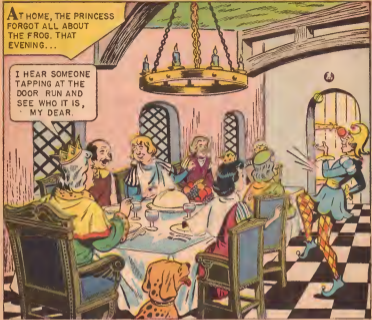
INDEED I HAVE! GOODBY, FOOLISH FROG!

DO NOT BE AFRAID OF ME, PRINCESS I WANT TO BE YOUR FRIEND.

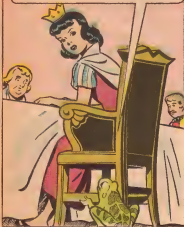


THE FROG FOLLOWED THE PRINCESS BACK TO THE TABLE.

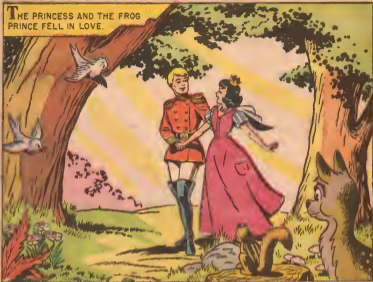
