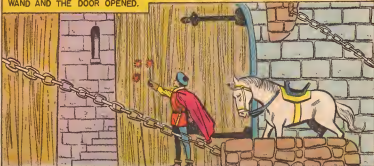
STRIKE THREE TIMES ON THE CASTLE DOOR WITH THE MAGIC WAND AND IT WILL SPRING OPEN.

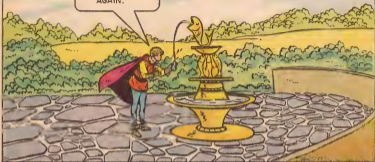
NO. I WANT ONE MORE THING. WILL YOU MARRY ME?

THAT IS TRUE.



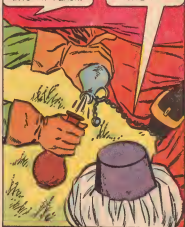

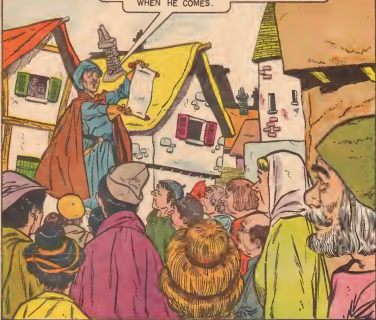

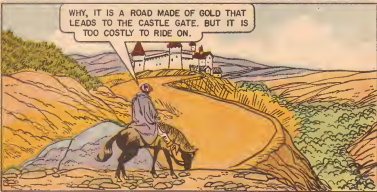


**T**HE OLDEST BROTHER RODE UNTIL HE CAME NEAR THE ENCHANTED CASTLE.

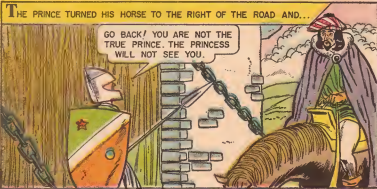

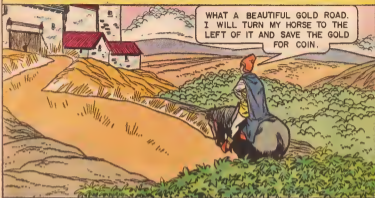


**T**HE PRINCE TURNED HIS HORSE TO THE RIGHT OF THE ROAD AND...

GO BACK! YOU ARE NOT THE TRUE PRINCE. THE PRINCESS WILL NOT SEE YOU.



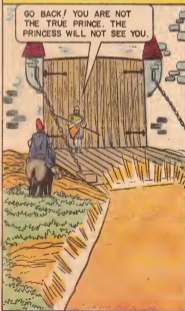
THEN THE SECOND PRINCE SET OUT TO WIN THE BEAUTIFUL PRINCESS. SOON . . .

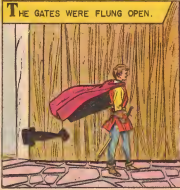

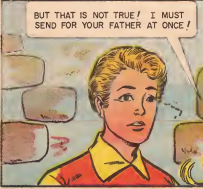


**I**NSIDE THE CASTLE, THE PRINCESS SAW THAT THE PRINCE WAS TROUBLED.

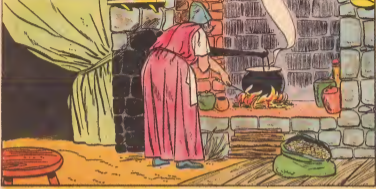

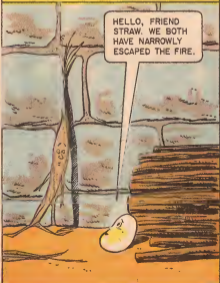
ONE DAY AN OLD WOMAN DECIDED TO BOIL SOME BEANS FOR LUNCH.

I'M SO HOT! I'D HAVE BURNED TO ASHES BEFORE LONG IN SUCH A FIRE!



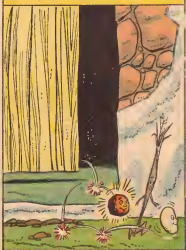

**T**HE MORE FRIGHTENED SHE BECAME, THE REDDER SHE GREW.

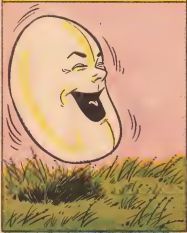


PLEASE MOVE QUICKLY! YOU ARE BURNING ME IN HALF!

OH, MY! I'VE RIPPED MY COAT WIDE OPEN!

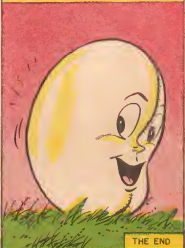


**A** TAILOR WHO WAS PASSING BY SAW WHAT HAD HAPPENED.
