WHAT'S THE USE? TOBY HAS FOUR LEGS AND I HAVE ONLY TWO. NO WONDER HE RUNS FASTER!

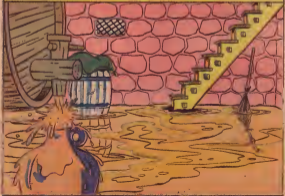


SHE WAS SO TIRED, SHE SAT DOWN TO REST

LUNCH BUT CIDER

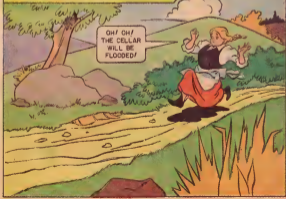


CIDER! OH, MY

KATE FELL FURTHER AND FURTHER BEHIND.

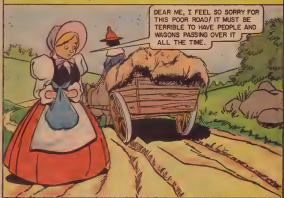
YOU MUST WALK A BIT FASTER, KATE.

WHEN THE BUTTER WAS USED UP, KATE STARTED TO PICK UP THE BREAD AND THE CHEESE BUT SUDDENLY



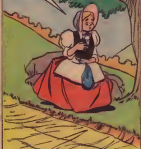
DOWN THE HILL ROLLED THE CHEESE, AND KATE WENT RUNNING AFTER.

AND BRING BACK SOMETHING ELSE TO EAT! I AM STILL HUNGRY!



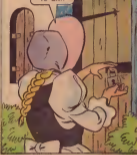
KATE RAN ALL THE WAY HOME.

WELL, THERE'S NO USE CRYING. WHAT'S DONE IS DONE.

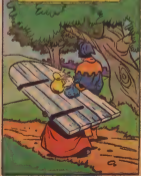


BUT AS LONG AS YOU BROUGHT THE DOOR, KATE, YOU MUST CARRY IT YOURSELF.

THE THIEVES FLED, AND FREDERICK AND KATE CLIMBED DOWN.

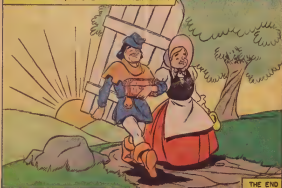

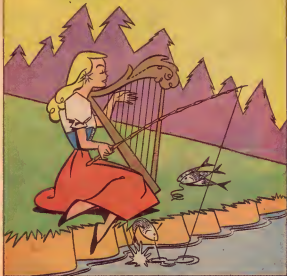
