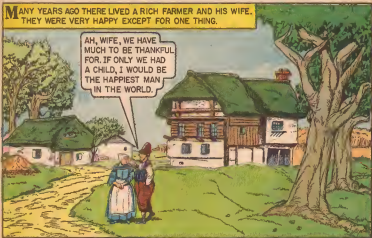


# THE HAPPY HEDGEHOG
